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The Ministry of Foreign Affairs and International Cooperation of the Co-operative Republic of Guyana presents its compliments to the Embassy of the United States of America in Guyana and wishes to express its willingness to consider accepting the transfer by the United States to Guyana of third-country nationals present in the United States.

The Government of Guyana would retain complete discretion to accept or reject the transfer of any given individual proposed by the Government of the United States of America.

The Government of Guyana assures the Government of the United States of America that it intends to treat any third-country nationals transferred from the United States to Guyana in a manner that is consistent with its obligations under the Convention Against Torture and Other Cruel, Inhuman, or Degrading Treatment or Punishment, adopted in New York on December 10, 1984; the principle of nonrefoulement; any other international legal obligations; and the constitution, laws, regulations, and immigration and visa policies of Guyana. Consistent with this intention, the Government of Guyana assures the Government of the United States of America that no third-country nationals transferred by the United States to Guyana would be subjected to persecution on account of race, religion, nationality, membership in a particular social group, or political opinion, or torture in Guyana; nor would Guyana further transfer any third-country national to a country in which they would be subjected to such persecution or torture, including their home country.

The Government of Guyana is committed to working with the Government of the United States to develop, to the extent appropriate, operating procedures to assist with implementation. Further, the Government of Guyana intends to consult with the Government of the United States to resolve any questions regarding interpretation or implementation of this understanding.

The Government of Guyana may decide, at any time, that it is no longer willing to consider accepting the transfer from the United States to Guyana of third-country nationals present in the United States and in such case, intends to communicate that decision in writing to the Government of the United States of America.

The Ministry of Foreign Affairs and International Cooperation of the Co-operative Republic of Guyana avails itself of this opportunity to renew to the Embassy of the United States of America in Guyana the assurances of its highest consideration.
